## **This Historic Poughkeepsie Development Will Revitalize a Longstanding Arlington School**



The Arthur S. May Elementary School will reopen as a commercial and residential center on Raymond Avenue directly across the street and in walking distance to the Arlington Reformed Church.

The old Arthur S. May Elementary School at 25-31 Raymond Avenue is ready for a second life. The school, which dates back to the 1920s and was part of the Arlington Central School District, closed its doors in 2014 and has remained vacant ever since.

For the past four years, Arthur May Redevelopment, LLC, (AMR), an affiliate of the family-owned, Poughkeepsie-based PAZ Management, Inc., has chipped away at a site plan for approval by the Town of Poughkeepsie Planning Board. It received the OK and has broken ground this month. The site will be the home to 159 apartments as well as businesses and shops, bike paths and seating benches...and hopefully a parking lot.

**We hope to be able to support the work across the street by opening our fellowship hall during the week to workers to use for lunch break.**
