### 5 THROUGH AGED 11

In Arlington Kids class, kids are engaged in teaching that will help them learn to make wiser choices, build stronger relationships, and develop a deeper authentic faith.

We use Sermons4Kids curriculum to teach the kids a full Bible lesson each

week. With Sermons4Kids, the kids are taught with object lessons, children's activities, Bible coloring pages, games, and crafts. Different materials are provided during class for each age group in attendance.

The kids watch animated Bible lesson videos, are given beautiful handouts, and are provided daily discussion questions to give their parents.

## SERMONS4KIDS

### Safe Church Policy

We follow Safe Church Protocols when working with children.

We additionally follow these safety precautions:

- All children are registered so we have parent contact information and permissions.
- Nursery and classrooms are disinfected after each use.
- Parent that signed a child in must pick them up

### Sick Child Policy

It is our desire to provide a healthy and safe environment for all the children. In general, children with the following symptoms should not be dropped off:

Fever, diarrhea, or vomiting within the last 48 hours, a green or yellow runny nose, an eye or skin infections; and/or other symptoms of communicable or infectious disease.

Children who are observed by our workers to be ill will have their parent or guardian contacted so the child be picked up.

### Medications Policy

It is the policy of Arlington Reformed Church not to administer either prescription or non-prescription medications to the children under our care. Medications should be administered by a parent at home.

Exceptions to the medications policy may be granted to parents of children with potentially life-threatening conditions (such as asthma or severe allergic reactions). Parents of such children should address their situation with the Church Administrator.

### Discipline Policy

We don't administer corporal punishment, even if parents have suggested or given permission for it. There is no spanking, grabbing, hitting, or other physical discipline of children. If assistance is needed with disciplinary issues, the parent or guardian is always contacted.
